### Stations of the Cross

We will be celebrating Stations of the Cross this month. This is a 14-step devotion that commemorates Jesus Christ's last day on earth as a man, beginning with this condemnation. The stations are commonly used as a mini-pilgrimage as one moves from station to station. At each station, the individual recalls or meditates on a specific event from Christ's last day. Specific prayers are recited, and then the individual moves to the next station until all 14 are complete. Everyone is welcome to join us in the church on these Fridays during Lent:
